No. 9976 /Coop., Date : 22-12-14
II-Legal 47/2013

Whereas, consequent upon promulgation of the Odisha Self-Help Co-operatives Ordinance, 2013 (Odisha Ordinance 1 of 2013) which was subsequently replaced by Odisha Self-Help Co-operatives (Repeal) Act, 2013 (Odisha Act 22 of 2013), the Self-Help Co-operatives are deemed to have been registered under the Odisha Co-operative Societies Act, 1962,

And

Whereas, it has been reported the OM SHANTI Transport & Multi-Purpose Co-operative Ltd., AT-Tingishmal (Sahajbahal), PO-Kudaloi, PS-Lakhanpur, Dist-Jharsuguda (Odisha) is not having the required number of members as provided under section 6(2) of the O.C.S Act, 1962 for registration/continuance as a Co-operative Society,

And

Whereas, the erstwhile the OM SHANTI Transport & Multi-Purpose Co-operative Ltd., now converted to Co-operative Society was constituted of Project Affected Persons (PAPs) for taking up transportation contract from the Mahanadi Coal Fields Ltd.

And

Whereas, the Board of Coal India Limited stipulates that 'Co-operative Society will be formed of the Project Affected Persons (PAPs) only' in order to be eligible for coal transportation on behalf of Mahanadi Coal Fields Limited and since required number of PAPs as member of the aforesaid Co-operative Society are not available in a contiguous area to fulfil the criteria for registration/ continuance as a Co-operative Society as per provision of the OCS Act, 1962.

Therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under section 122 of the OCS Act, 1962, Government do hereby exempt the OM SHANTI Transport & Multi-Purpose Co-operative Ltd., (deemed to have been registered under the OCS Act, 1962) from the requirement of minimum number of members as provided under section 6(2) of the said
